The 2019 Summer Reading Program (SRP) begins June 6th and the Lake Benton Public Library has many fantastic events planned for your kids and grandkids this year. We will have weekly reading programs for three different age groups and special events throughout the summer. Kids don't have to come to the weekly events in order to come to the special events and they don't have to come to every weekly event in order to enjoy the program. Additionally, we will have a "Wall of Fame" where we will have "Award Stars" for every book the child reads. The "Award Stars" will include child's name and their favorite book for that round!

The theme for the Summer Reading Program will be "It's Showtime". Each week we will host a weekly reading club for three age groups as follows:

- Preschool, Kindergarten & 1st grade
- 2nd grade through 5th grade
- 6th grade

These weekly events will be based on "It's Showtime" themes which are as follows:

- June 6th - "Lights, Camera, Action"
- June 13th - "The Star is Born"
- June 20th - "Amazing Emmy's"
- June 27th - "Now Starring"
- July 4th - No Reading Programs
- July 11th - "Mystery Theater"
- July 18th - "Intermission"
- July 25th - No Reading Programs
- July 26th - Grand Finale

This program's packet will be sent home with students at the local school or can be picked up at the library. As usual, our program will culminate with a Grand Finale, Friday, July 26th. Our grand finale theme will be "It's Showtime at the Zoo, with special guests from the W.H. Petting Zoo. The grand finale will be held at the Hole-in-the-Mountain Park and Chalet at 1:00 to 3:00. It will include a light snack, a fun craft, and a lot of fun with the wonderful animals that will be present.

We will again have a weekly challenge to connect learning and home. These challenges, as well as the program calendar and other fun extras, will be included in our SRP packet, available at the library when you turn in your registration form beginning May 13th.





