


Country Mouse and City Mouse: The Mouseical!




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Programs for everyone:

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The 2018 Summer Reading Program (SRP) begins June 6th and the Lake Benton Public Library has many fantastic events planned for your kids and grandkids this year. We will have weekly reading programs for five different age groups and special events throughout the summer. Kids don't have to come to the weekly events in order to come to the special events and they don't have to come to every weekly event in order to enjoy the program. Additionally, as in past years, kids can read to earn prizes!

The theme for the elementary Summer Reading Program will be "Reading Takes You Everywhere". Each week we will host a weekly reading club for three age groups—Preschool, Kindergarten through 1st grade, and 2nd grade through 5th grade. These weekly events will be based on "Reading Takes You Everywhere" themes and will include a weekly challenge.

We haven't forgotten our older students who have finished fifth grade or beyond. This year, the Tweens 6th through 8th grades will participate in a fun program designed for advanced readers, "Frankenstein." As part of the 'Tweens program, students will also get to have a lock-in at the library. This program's packet will be sent home with students in sixth grade or can be picked up at the library.

There will also, be a group for High School students and they will be reading books by H.P. Lovecraft. They also, will have a lock-in at the library.

As usual, our program will culminate with a Grand Finale, Friday, July 27. Our grand finale theme will be Reading takes you into the wild, with special guests from the W.H. Petting Zoo. The grand finale will be held at the Hole-in-the-Mountain Park and Chalet at 1:00 to 3:00. It will include a light snack, a fun craft, and a lot of fun with the wonderful animals that will be present.

You can find our weekly themes in this packet. We will again have a weekly challenge to connect learning and home. These challenges, as well as the program calendar and other fun extras, will be included in our SRP packet, available at the library when you turn in your registration form beginning May 14th.

Families can sign up for the SRP with the attached form. Everyone enrolled in the program will receive a fun bag, filled with goodies, and complete details about the events and program. Registrations are due by June 4.

Minnesota Zoo Conservation

This program is for all ages

We will take folks on a nature walk at Hole in the Mountain Prairie Preserve. We will have notebooks for everyone in attendance. Older kids will be invited to use the notebooks to write down what we see and/or make field observations (much like we'd do while conducting a field survey). We'll also have some unlined notebooks for younger kids who may not have learned to write- they can draw what they see 😊 While we walk, we will point out some of the wildflowers, butterflies, birds, and other species we see. We will also have a few 'explorer kits' for folks to use. They'll each have a set of binoculars, some fold out guides to some common Minnesota species, and a magnifying glass. After the event, the kits will be available for check out at library and use them on their own nature hikes 😊
