

Lake Benton Public Library Outreach Program

Reading opens the door to the world outside, so the Lake Benton Public Library offers an outreach program for homebound patrons living in the Lake Benton community.

Twice a month, a library volunteer will deliver books and/or audiobooks right to the front doors of homebound patrons. Homebound patrons can order specific titles, authors and/or genres by calling the library to speak to a librarian or giving a list to the volunteer delivery person. Delivery/pickup will be the first and third Wednesdays of every month.

Signing up for this program is easy. Simply call the library at 507-368-4641, ext. 4 to get started.

The Lake Benton Public Library would like to welcome our computer users back. We have two computers and two Chromebooks available for patrons to use. We also have four wireless hotspots available for check out. Don't forget to check out our digital books and audiobooks as well.

We have opened two computers for patrons to use. We also offer two Chromebooks, which can be checked out or used in the library. In order to keep both our patrons and our staff as safe as possible, we have implemented the following protocols for computer users.

Please sign in at the front desk. Please include your name and time in. Please limit your use to 30 minutes, with a maximum of one hour. This allows everyone to use the computer safely and in a timely manner. Desktop computers have direct printing ability. See library staff to print from a Chromebook or other digital device in the library.

We also offer free WiFi on our back patio. Stop in for a refreshing drink (coffee, cocoa or tea) and sit on our back patio while you surf the web.

Hotspots allow patrons to use the internet anywhere ATT wireless service is available. Take the internet with you wherever you go, whether it is camping or to a hotel. Hotspots are available for adult patrons and can only be checked out for one week. See one of us for complete details on the hotspots.


